“Holy, Holy, Holy, Lord God Almighty, which was, and is, and is to come”
Revelation 4:8.

‘Eternity can be likened to the piece of paper on which the line is drawn. Both the beginning and the end of the line are visible at one glance.’ The late C. S. Lewis gave us this helpful illustration about the vital connection between ‘time’ and ‘eternity.’ He suggested that ‘time’ could be likened to a line that is drawn on a piece of paper: This line has a ‘start’ and a ‘finish.’

In the Bible **hundreds of prophecies about future events are precisely accurate because they were inspired by ‘the One who knows the end from the beginning.’** God has no yesterday, no today, and no tomorrow. Forever He will be what He always was—in other words—**He is the God of eternity!** To try to comprehend this, we could exclaim with King David: *“Such knowledge is too wonderful for me; it is high, I cannot attain unto it”* Psalm 139:6.

“Remember the former things of old: for I am God, and there is none else; I am God, and there is none like Me, Declaring the end from the beginning, and from ancient times the things that are not yet done, saying, My counsel shall stand, and I will do all My pleasure ... I have spoken it, I will also bring it to pass; I have purposed it, I will also do it” Isaiah 46:9-11.

As the Lord Jesus said: *“Verily, verily, I say unto you, he that heareth My Word, and believeth on Him that sent Me, hath everlasting life”* John 5:24.
